Justice in Blue and Gray, A Legal History of the Civil War, by the eminent historian of public international law and the law of war, Stephen C. Neff, is intended as primarily a case study of the myriad ways in which law plays an important role in a crisis of giant political and military dimensions. Stephen Neff teaches international law, and that shows from the first page of *Justice in Blue and Gray*, where it is already clear that international law is the book's focus.
